

ORDINANCE NO. 02-2024

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING IN DESIGNATED AREAS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH WEBSTER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council desires to maximize the safety of its residents;

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of South Webster, Ohio as follows:

**Section 1: PROHIBITIONS**

Parking may be prohibited at all times on certain streets, roadways, or portions thereof. When signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle upon any street or roadway so posted.

Parking may be temporarily limited on certain streets, roadways, areas, zones, or parking spaces to which access has been restricted or in which parking is prohibited by the placement of signs, barricades, traffic cones, or other devices or markings. No person shall park a vehicle in violation of these limits so posted.

**Section 2: PENALTY**

Whoever violates any provision of this ordinance is guilty of a minor misdemeanor on a first offense; on a second offense within one year after the first offense, such person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree; on each subsequent offense within one year after the first offense, such person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree. Each offense is subject to a fine of \$100.


**Section 3:**

That two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected or appointed to Council have found this to be an emergency measure to provide for the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village and its residents and therefore this ordinance shall go into immediate effect upon its passage.

**Section 4:**


The provisions of this ordinance supersede the provisions of any existing ordinance or resolution that may be in conflict.
